WHAT DOES THE DELAWARE NATIONAL BANK OF DELHI DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

WHY?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

WHAT?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Credit History
- Payment History
- Wire Transfer Instructions
- Transaction or Loss History
- Overdraft History

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

HOW?

All Financial companies need to share non-public personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their non-public personal information; the reasons The Delaware National Bank of Delhi chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do	
How does The Delaware National Bank of Delhi protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does The Delaware National Bank of Delhi collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: • Open an Account • Apply for a Loan • Deposit Money • Make a Wire Transfer • Show your Driver's License We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • <i>The Delaware National Bank of Delhi does not share with our affiliates</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • <i>The Delaware National Bank of Delhi does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • <i>The Delaware National Bank of Delhi doesn't jointly market</i>
